Monism: Pantheism / Panentheism.
Influenced by: Eastern Mysticism (Hinduism [Advaita Vedanta], Mahayana/Tantric Buddhism); Hermeticism, Kabbalah, and Western Esotericism; Manichaeism and Gnosticism; Ancient Greek Henotheism and Mythology; New Age; Science (especially Theory of Evolution).

- The One:** as the Void, the Source. The Everything that equals Nothing. Impersonal Field or Principle representing Pure Possibility or Potentiality (undifferentiated white chaos metaphor). **Flawed Godhead:** the first differentiation (concept) of Universal Mind as Origin of the Other (Multiplicity / Dualism and Evil [Monitor / Anti-Monitor]).
- Dualist Cosmology / Union of Opposites:** Non-Duality or Ultimate Identity of Opposites. E.g., Light and Darkness define, imply and create each other.
- Self-Transcendence:** by Re-Uniting the pieces back to the Totality in the Source (Kabbalah/Gnostic variation). By Awakening (Gnosis): we are already God (Hindu variation, "God Knowing Himself through Us").
- Plurality as enemy of the One:** Particularity necessarily Dualistic, involving conflict (Heroes/Villains). Macrocosmic/Microcosmic correspondence (As Above, so Below).
- Cyclical Cosmology / Existence (Hinduism / Buddhism):** Life as Illusion, Cycles of Creation / Destruction, Reincarnation and Karma. Tantric Buddhist Afterlife (Bardo).
- Gnostic Re-interpretation of Christian Concepts:** Questionable Christian Old testament God (The Presence); Lucifer as Sympathetic figure and counterpart of Michael (Kabbalah).
